- *Visit educational videos on You Tube such as; Alphablocks, Have Fun Teaching, ABCMouse, Numberjacks etc.*

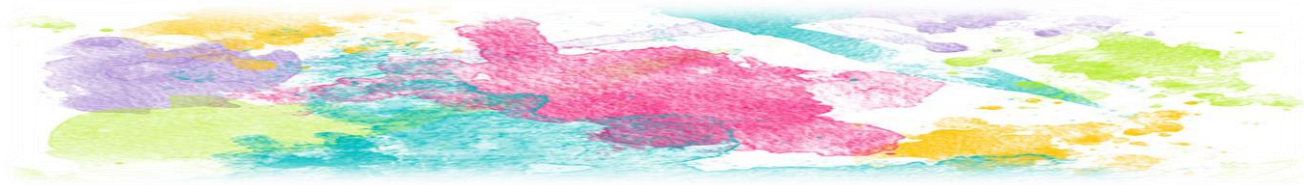
There are no expectations that the Preps do a lot of homework in the holidays though, as we have another big term ahead of us!
