PURPOSE

Student Impact Team (SIT) provides a means by which students can be formally involved in ceremonies, events and fundraising at the school. They participate in making decisions about and organising a range of events and initiatives to raise awareness of different issues and celebrate days of significance. SIT liaise with the Principal, the School Improvement Team (staff leadership) and School Council, to gain approval for events and initiatives.

- To develop student leadership qualities
- To provide our students with a voice
- To actively participate in identifying and raising funds for charitable organisations.

POLICY

GUIDELINES FOR IMPLEMENTATION

- The membership of the Student Impact Team (SIT) comprises of a number of year 6 leaders, meet weekly as part of the school's Leadership Program, under the guidance and direction of a designated member of staff. When required, representatives of each class throughout the school who serve as members of SIT will meet to discuss issues requiring student voice.
- Reports, recommendations and requests from the SIT will be presented to staff, school leadership and to the School Council.
- SIT members will be actively engaged in nominated SIT activities and promote the work of their membership.
- An opportunity will be provided for some SIT members to attend a meeting of School Council to seek approval for fundraising activities.
