Our Learning Intentions...

Literacy Letters 'sh', 'th', 'ch', 'ph' digraph	Students will be introduced to the alphabet letter by letter. They will be exposed to various learning styles in the teaching of these letters in order to ascertain their understanding through various tools; such as cued articulation, hands on, visual and oral. This week we will be revising the blends we have learnt this term. Reading groups will encompass a range of activities that will be differentiated to your child's needs.
Numeracy	This week in Maths lessons, students will be revising the Maths topics that they have learnt about this year. These topics include addition, subitising, time, shapes and patterns.
Integrated	The Prep students will continue to take an in depth look at All Creatures Great & Small and reflect on what they enjoyed learning most this term about animals.
